



Futuro con ir

Paso a paso

To use the future in Spanish with "ir," you will need to conjugate the verb "ir" in the present tense and then add the preposition "a" followed by the infinitive of the main verb. Here's how to conjugate "ir" in the present tense:

Subject	Ir
Yo	Voy
Tù	Vas
Èl, ella, usted	Va
nosotros/nosotras	Vamos
Ellos, ellas, ustedes	Van



To form the future tense with "ir," you simply need to use the appropriate form of "ir" from the table above, followed by the preposition "a" and the infinitive of the main verb. Here are some examples:

Subject	Future with "ir"	Example
Yo	voy a estudiar	Voy a estudiar mañana. (I am going to study tomorrow.)
Tù	vas a comer	¿Vas a comer en el restaurante? (Are you going to eat at the restaurant?)
Èl, ella, usted	va a viajar	Èl va a viajar el próximo mes. (He is going to travel next month.)
nosotros/nosotros	vamos a ver	Vamos a ver una película esta noche. (We are going to watch a movie tonight.)
Ellos, ellas, ustedes	van a llegar	Ellos van a llegar tarde. (They are going to arrive late.)



Note that the preposition "a" is always used before the infinitive of the main verb when forming the future with "ir." This is because "ir" is functioning as an auxiliary verb in this construction, indicating future tense.

Mañana voy a hacer la tarea. (Tomorrow, I am going to do the homework.)



Conjugate the verb "ir" in the present tense for each subject:

Example: Yo ____ a la escuela todos los días. (I go to school every day.)

Answer: voy

5. Yo ____ al supermercado. (**I am going to the supermarket.**)
6. Tú ____ a la fiesta de cumpleaños. (**You are going to the birthday party.**)
7. Él ____ al parque con su perro. (**He is going to the park with his dog.**)
8. Nosotros ____ a la playa este fin de semana. (**We are going to the beach this weekend.**)

Questions using the future tense with "ir" for Spanish learners:

1. ¿Adónde vas a ir de vacaciones este año? (**Where are you going to go on vacation this year?**)
2. ¿Vas a ir al cine este fin de semana? (**Are you going to go to the movies this weekend?**)
3. ¿Van a ir ustedes a la fiesta de cumpleaños de Juan? (**Are you all going to Juan's birthday party?**)
4. ¿Qué vas a hacer después de la escuela hoy? (**What are you going to do after school today?**)
5. ¿Vas a estudiar para el examen de matemáticas mañana? (**Are you going to study for the math exam tomorrow?**)



Questions using the future tense with "ir" for Spanish learners:

1. ¿Van a ir ustedes al concierto de música latina la próxima semana? **(Are you all going to the Latin music concert next week?)**
2. ¿Qué van a comer en el restaurante esta noche? **(What are you going to eat at the restaurant tonight?)**
3. ¿Vas a comprar un regalo para tu amigo por su cumpleaños? **(Are you going to buy a gift for your friend for their birthday?)**
4. ¿Van a visitar a sus abuelos en el campo durante las vacaciones de verano? **(Are you going to visit your grandparents in the countryside during summer vacation?)**
5. ¿Qué van a hacer para celebrar el Día de Acción de Gracias este año? **(What are you going to do to celebrate Thanksgiving this year?)**
